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Lesson

Forests cover 30% of the earth's land, but we cut down some of those trees for many reasons. To make room for housing developments, highways, Farm land & to make things like paper, houses & furniture. Cutting down trees to be used for somethings is ok, but deforestation is what it's called when all the trees in an entire forest are cut down by humans on purpose. The loss of trees also means some animals lose their homes, the area could flood, the air becomes polluted & there is no other vegetation around. Sometimes accidental fires can cause a huge loss in the forests as well. In some areas like Oregon, logging companies are required to replant trees & rotate where they source from. By Reducing our use of & reusing & recycling paper products, we can help the trees. Also try planting a tree where you live & work to regrow your areas tree canopy.



Instructions



1. Gather all your materials.
2. Go through an old magazine & find some pictures you like. It can be of people, animals, or any other funny photos you find. Tear or cut out the pages.
3. Now start cutting out the different parts of a faces, like eyes, nose, mouth etc...
4. On the thicker paper or cardboard, draw the shape of a head if you want & start mixing up the face parts you found. Once you get combinations you like, glue them down. You can mix & match the parts like, for example, maybe use a girls eye & a cats mouth. What silly pictures can you make? The sillier the better!
5. Optional - now use crayon/markers to color & decorate your new funny face Creations. How many can you make?



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
